Assault Family Violence Impeding Breath, Evading Arrest on Foot

On Wednesday March 11, 2015 at 04:00pm Officers were called to the Adult Probation Office in Harlingen in reference to a male who had two active warrants for assault family violence impeding breath and evading arrest on foot from San Benito Police. Officers arrived and made contact with 36 year old Felipe Ulloa. Mr. Ulloa had an argument with a female at a residence on the 200 block of W. Robertson on March 4, 2015 which led to the assault charge. Ulloa had a verbal dispute with the female that turned physical when she refused to give him the keys to her vehicle. Ulloa spit in the face of the victim and began to choke her. She was able to break free from Ulloa and call police. As police arrived Ulloa began to run toward the alley and was instructed several times to "stop" by police. A report of the incident was documented and warrants were later obtained for 3rd Degree Felony Assault Family Violence Impeding Breath and Class A Misdemeanor Evading Arrest on Foot. Ulloa was arraigned by Judge David Garza and bond was set at \$20,000 dollars and an Emergency Protective Order was placed for the victim.
