BURGLARY OF HABITATION

FRIDAY AUGUST 14TH, 2015



On Thursday August 14th, 2015, at 7:30 pm. San Benito Police Officers responded to the intersection of Sherer Road and FM 732 in order to assist a Cameron County Sheriff's Deputy who was out with a wanted subject out of this agency. When the Police Officers arrived at location they identified the wanted subject as 18 year old Samuel Benavidez who had an outstanding warrant for his arrest for the offense of burglary of habitation (2nd degree Felony) issued by Justice Court. Samuel Benavidez was wanted in connection to a burglary that occurred in February 16, 2015 at a residence located on the 31000 block of FM 2520. San Benito Police Investigators were able to collect enough evidence against Samuel Benavidez that would implicate him in the burglary, and a warrant of arrest was obtained. Samuel Benavidez was placed under arrest, and taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Cameron County Justice of the Peace David Garza who set bond on the charge at \$75,000. Samuel Benavidez was also being sought by the Texas Juvenile Justice Department Office of Inspector General for being a parole violator.
