## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Deadly Conduct**

**June 15, 2016**



On Monday June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 03:31pm San Benito Police Officers were dispatched to the south bound Frontage Road and Oscar Williams in reference to Federal Agents needing assistance. The patrol officer arrived and made contact with a Customs and Border Protection Agent who had a male and female in custody and stated the male driver of a Tan Ford F-150 pointed a black in color pistol at him as he was traveling on the Expressway. The suspect vehicle took the Oscar Williams exit ramp and stopped at the red light. The CBP Agent exited his vehicle and attempted to pull the driver and passenger out of the vehicle at gunpoint. Agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) were in a separate vehicle at the red light and assisted the CBP Agent in the apprehension. The pistol described by the CBP Agent was located in the female's purse. San Benito Police Officer took Custody of the male and female and transported them to the city police station for questioning. 24 year old Travis Reese Lopez was charged with Deadly Conduct a Class A Misdemeanor. The female provided a statement of the incident and release. Mr. Lopez was arraigned by Judge David Garza and was released after posting a \$10,000 dollar bond.
