DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, ASSAULT FAMILY VIOLENCE

Roy Cantu

On Sunday June 23, 2013 at 02:35 am, a Patrol Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle on the intersection of Bowie St. and Landrum St. for speeding. The Officer made contact with the driver who identified himself as 37 year old Roy Cantu. The Officer noticed that Cantu had an odor of alcohol emitting from his breath and was asked to step out of the vehicle. Cantu agreed to perform a series of test to determine if he was capable to operate a motor vehicle. Cantu showed several signs of being intoxicated and was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated. He was transported to the city jail where he was later arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza. Cantu was released on a \$1,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond.

Billy Petree

On Sunday June 23, 2013 at 01:07 am a Patrol Officer conducted a traffic stop on the intersection of Business 77 and Lovett. The vehicle was traveling without headlights and was weaving in and out of its lane of travel. As the Officer was approaching the vehicle the driver opened his door and swung his legs out towards the street. The Officer ordered the driver to step out of the vehicle and as the driver was walking to the rear of the vehicle the Officer observed the driver to have poor balance. The driver identified himself as 30 year old Billy Petree. Petree was asked to perform the Field Sobriety Test to which he agreed. During the

test, Petree showed several signs of being intoxicated and was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated. As the Officer was inventorying the vehicle the Officer located a marble ceramic pipe used to smoke marijuana on the driver seat and a clear plastic bag containing a green leaf substance believed to be Marijuana located in the center console. Petree was also charged with Possession of Marijuana and taken to the city jail. He was later arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and Petree was given a \$1,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond for Driving While Intoxicated and a \$2,000 dollar bond for Possession of Marijuana.

Raymond Martinez Jr.

On Sunday June 23, 2013 at 01:02 pm, a female victim came to the San Benito Police Station and reported an assault that occurred on Menard St. The victim stated her husband who she identified as 32 year old Raymond Martinez Jr. had assaulted her over an argument they had earlier that day. The Investigating Officer made contact with Martinez via telephone and advised that charges for assault will be filed. Martinez turned himself in to authorities and was placed under arrest for Assault Family Violence. He was arraigned by Judge Benjamin Yudesis and was released on a \$5,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond.
