## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **AGGRAVATED ASSAULTS (FAMILY VIOLENCE)**

**MONDAY OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2012**



On Sunday September 30, 2012, at 12:29 am, San Benito Police Officers responded to the Stonewall Jackson Hotel located on the 200 block of East Stenger in reference to an assault. Upon the Officers arrival they made contact with a 33 female who told the Officers that her live-in boyfriend who she identified as 38 year old Victor Hugo Castro out of San Benito had pushed her to the ground where he punched her left side of her face on numerous occasions causing pain. Victim also advised the Police Officers that while they were driving home from Harlingen the alleged suspect displayed a knife on several occasions, and threatened to stab her with the knife. Victor Hugo Castro was then placed under arrest for Aggravated Assault with a deadly weapon (family violence), and transported to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$25,000. Arraigning Judge also issued an emergency protective order against Victor Hugo Castro.

On Sunday September 30, 2012, at 3:29 pm. San Benito Police responded to a mobile home park locate on the 100 Block of North Helen Moore Road in reference to an assault. Upon the Officers arrival they made contact with a 48 year old female who stated that her father who she identified as 76 year old George Paul Kelley out of San Benito had put a knife against her throat during a verbal confrontation. According to the victim, her father became upset after finding discrepancies on his bank statement. At that point the Officers proceeded to place George Kelley under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon (family violence), and was taken to City Jail where he was later arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bond at \$10,000.
