SUMMARY OF CDBG 48TH YEAR PROPOSED ONE YEAR ACTION PLAN

In compliance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirements, the City of San Benito hereby provides PUBLIC NOTICE that the Proposed One Year Action Plan for the B-20: 2022-2023 fiscal year in the amount of \$363,193.00 for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is available for public comment. There will be a 31-day comment period from June 24, 2022, through July 25, 2022. The Draft One Year Action Plan may be reviewed at the Community Grants and Programs Department, 401 North Sam Houston Boulevard, San Benito, Texas between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, on regular business days. The One Year Action Plan is a major component of the Consolidated Plan and sets forth the City's specific plan for activities that are expected to be implemented utilizing CDBG Funds during the fiscal year, which begins October 1, 2022 and ends on September 30, 2023. Each of the activities support priorities established in the Consolidated Plan.

- Benefit Low/Moderate income persons
- Prevent/Eliminate Slum and Blight
- Meet Urgent Needs
