MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION

RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

Due to current drought conditions, the City is under Stage 2 Mandatory Water Conservation restrictions per City ordinance until further notice. Please do your part to conserve water. Falcon and Amistad Reservoirs, which is where the entire Rio Grande Valley ultimately gets its water from, are critically LOW! Until our reservoirs are significantly replenished, we stand to run out of water. Which is why it's so important for all of us to conserve. For more information, scan the QR code

Stage 2 Mandatory Water Conservation

- No watering between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- All water running off yards, plants or other vegetation into gutters or streets is prohibited
- Vehicle washing at home may be done between the hours of 6 to 9 p.m. with a hose equipped with a shutoff nozzle or with a 5-gallon bucket
- The use of water to wash sidewalks, walkways, driveways or any building or structure is prohibited

It's time to clean up
This event is ONLY for San Benito residents



- Proof of residency required (water bill with address AND photo ID)
- Take your items to the City Service Center at 925 W. Stenger St. for disposal
- Accepted items include ONLY: brush, wood, appliances WITHOUT Freon, furniture, paper, fabric, plastic, and tires WITHOUT RIMS from RESIDENTS ONLY; limit 4 per household (NO COMMERCIAL ENTITIES, OR 18-WHEELER OR TRACTOR TIRES)
- NO residential or commercial construction/remodeling materials, paints or chemicals such as drywall and insulation
- Keep brush and wood separate from other items



Notice: This is a FREE event ONLY for San Benito residents. NO businesses or apartment complexes are permitted to bring trash/debris for dumping. If you cannot make it on this date, another event will be held in the fall.
